Tensions that lead up to the Red River Resistance:

- +18C sells Rupert's Land without consulting Métis.

- Land surveyors trespassed into Métis property when Canada had not bought the land yet.

Action that caused the formation of the National Metis Committee - Surveyors trespossed onto Métis Hay Privilege.
