Points of View

First Person: The narrator includes themselves in the story.

(Uses I, we, us)

Second Person: Usually an instructive piece of writing that tells you to do something.

(Uses You. Examples: Cookbooks.)

Third Person:

Omniscient: Narrator knows the thoughts about everyone

Limited Omniscient: Narrator knows the thoughts about one person

Objective: Narrator describes the story without going into anyone's thoughts.
